

COMMUNITY WASTE POLICY

To ensure the effective removal of waste by municipal services, the following garbage disposal policy has been established for all residents.

Non-compliance may result in waste not being collected, which not only leads to unsanitary conditions but also detracts significantly from the aesthetic appeal of our community.

Your cooperation is greatly appreciated and is essential in keeping our community looking its best.

- **Proper Bagging:** All waste materials must be placed in sealed plastic bags before being disposed of in the community garbage bins. This helps prevent spillage and keeps our surroundings clean.
- **Restricted Materials:** The following items are strictly prohibited from being disposed of in the community garbage bins:
 - Construction materials (e.g., bricks, drywall, wood)
 - Kitty litter and other types of fecal matter
 - Unbundled cardboard or wood
 - Glass or mirrors
 - Recycling materials (recycling program to come soon)
- Securing Trash Bins: Ensure that all trash bin doors are fully closed and secured after disposal. This prevents animals from accessing the bins and reduces the risk of waste spillage.
- **Composting:** Residents are encouraged to compost organic waste. Composting reduces the amount of waste in our bins and provides a valuable resource for gardening and landscaping.
- Reporting Issues: Any problems with the garbage bins, including damage, overfilling, or non-collection of waste, should be promptly reported to the Operations Manager for immediate attention.
